DO-NOTHING IS NOT ABOUT NOT DOING ANYTHING.

Unparenting is about UNDOING the damages inflicted on children by the modern parenting. Modern parents are 'products' of modern school and market, totally destroyed of their natural instincts, sensitivity, common sense and natural intelligence. They are made to depend on books, experts and products and not on their biological instinct to NURTURE which like breathing is an effortless activity.

DAY 1: WHO NEED TO CHANGE? Children or parents? Shifting from changing children's behaviour to changing our behaviour. Understanding the difference in paradigm of children and us. Exploring the difficulty in understanding inherent nature of children. Understand how we have become conformists, afraid of exploration, lacking creativity and openness

DAY 1: UNDERSTANDING THE INHERENT NATURE OF LIFE- TO BE AUTONOMOUS, TO BE IN TRUTH, TO SUSTAIN LIFE AT ALL COSTS . Why what How children learn? How children simplify content? How children deepen and widen their knowledge?

DAY 2: UNDERSTANDING DO-NOTHING PROCESS OF LIFE
The way we learned our mother tongue- no one taught consciously no one learned purposely. Beauty- the effortless response in children.

DAY 2: BIOLOGICAL ADAPTATION TO TWO-DIMENSIONAL REALM Exploring how children use drawing- essentially a two-dimensional activity to understand the connection between the world and the word.

DAY 3: CREATING LEARNING ENVIRONMENT - Reimagining homes, schools – reducing the damages, developing non- teaching pedagogy, reimagining art as sensing, feeling and being.
